Tip of the Week

Interviewing for an internship or entry-level job? When the interview is coming to a close if you realize that you really do want the job, make a statement reiterating your interest in the job and how much you want to work for the company. Don't assume the interviewers know you want the job.

Finally, "before you leave the interview, make sure to ask about the next steps in the hiring process so you know what to expect going forward. Ask your interviewer if they have a certain time frame in which they'll get back to you with a decision, or if there are any other layers of interviews you should prepare for."

Account activation requires a review of your resume by Engineering Career Services.

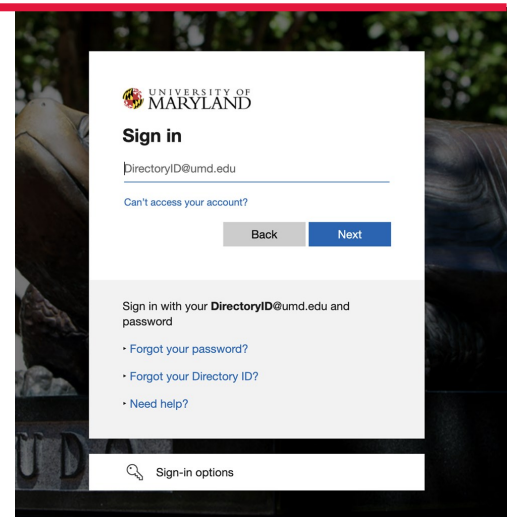

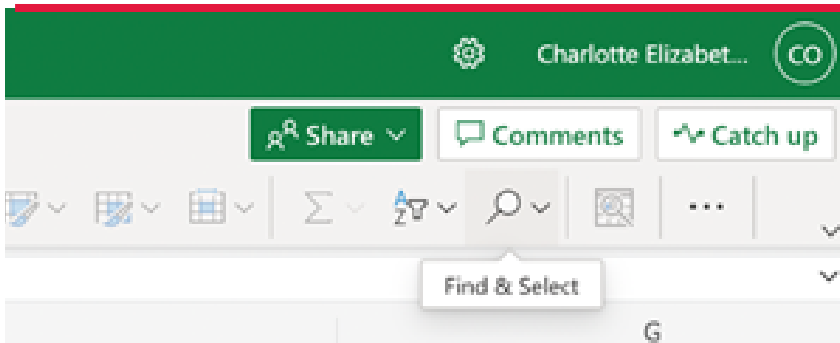

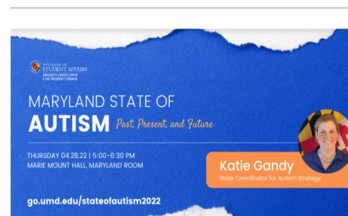
