## Office of Civil Rights & Sexual Misconduct

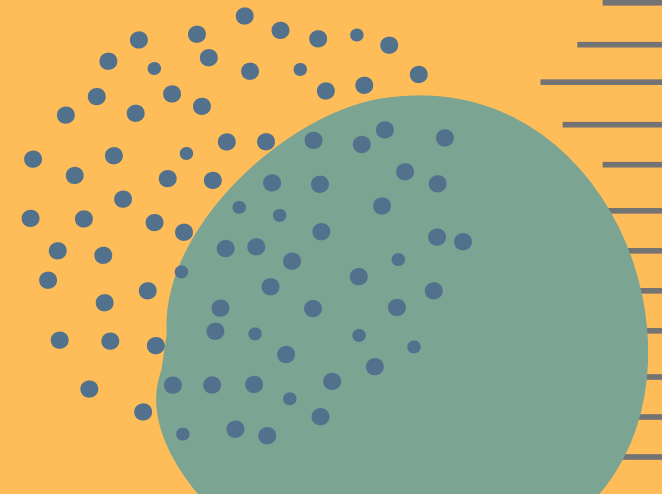
OCRSM administers the University of Maryland's non-discrimination policies and works to foster a learning and working environment free from all forms of discrimination and harassment, including sexual misconduct.

## Undergraduate Student Government Association (SGA)

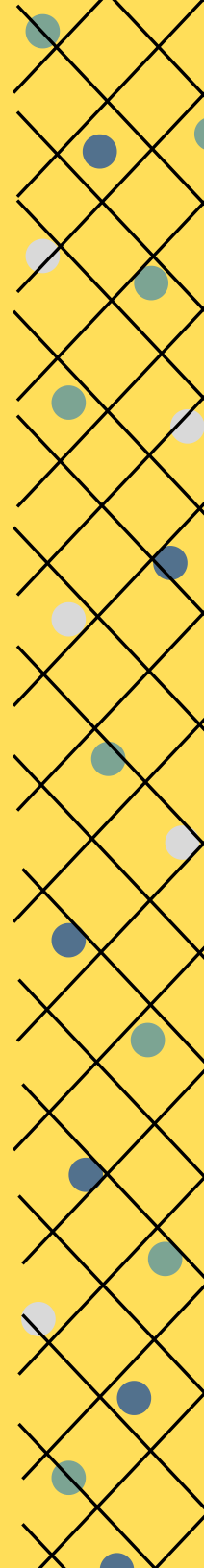
The SGA is the governance body for all undergraduate students at the University of Maryland, College Park. The organization works with various student groups, administrators, and government officials to ensure student interests are met.
