

Uploading Zoom (and other) Video to Canvas

If you have any supplemental videos, Zoom recordings, or any other video content you can upload these to Canvas using Panopto.

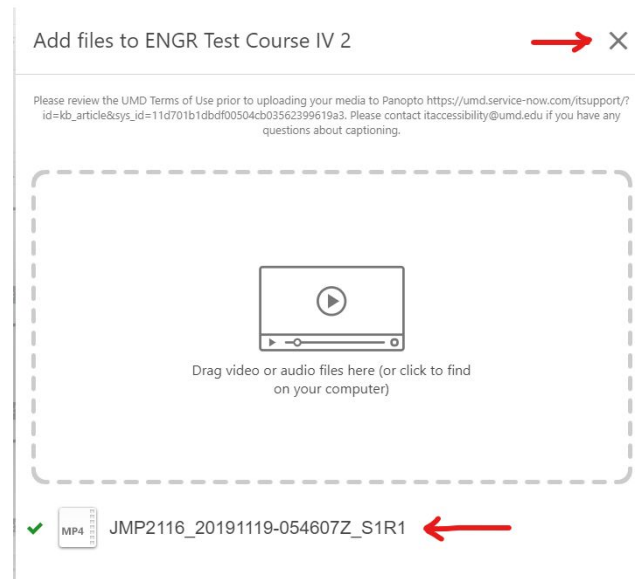
Log in to Canvas and navigate to the “Panopto Recordings” page using the link on the left side of the page. If you have used Panopto in the past, you will see thumbnails of your Panopto media. Click the “Create” button at the top of the page.

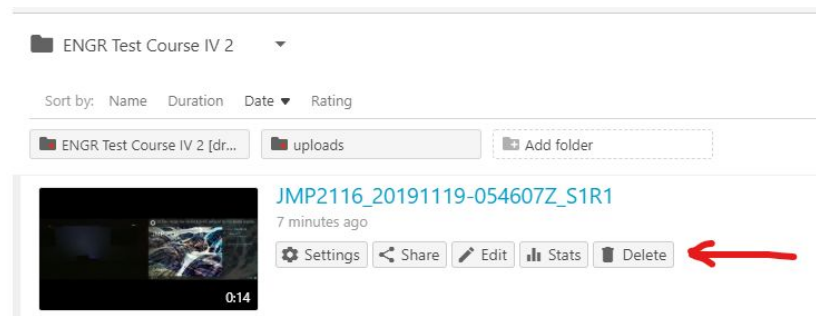
From the drop-down menu, choose “Upload Media”.
